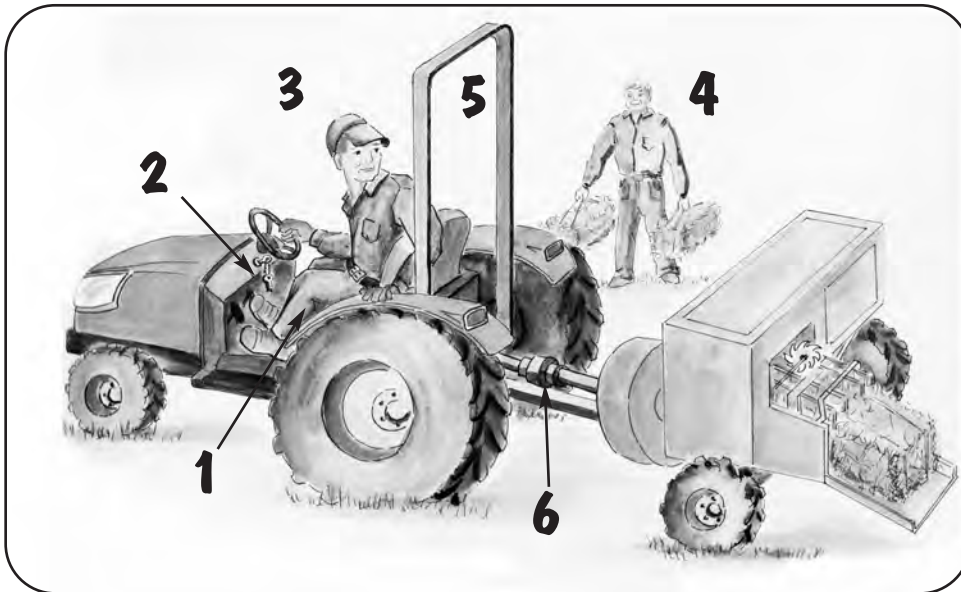


TEST YOUR TRACTOR SAFETY I.Q.

What is a PTO?

It stands for “power take-off.” A PTO provides power to an attachment on a tractor – like a hay baler – and is very dangerous. It is easy to get loose clothing caught in a PTO.
